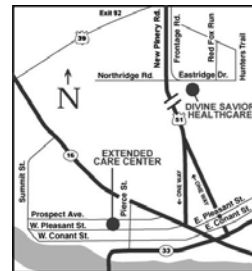

By car from Madison: Take I-90/I-94 north to I-39. Exit on HWY 33. Take HWY 33 east to Fairfield (Levee) Road. Blystone Towing is on this intersection. Continue on Fairfield Road to Statz Rd. Follow Statz Road until it ends. **There is a bridge with less than 12 foot clearance on Fairfield/Levee Road. If you are driving a motorhome, or pulling a 5th wheel, please use alternate route! ALTERNATE ROUTE:

Big Rigs: Take I-90/I-94 north to I-39. Exit onto HWY 33. Go WEST on HWY 33 over the Baraboo River. Just past the river, turn right on HWY U. Where HWY U junctions with Schepp Rd, take Schepp Rd north to Levee (Fairfield) Rd. Turn Right on Levee Rd and travel approximately 4 miles to Statz Rd. BREED STANDARD QUALIFICATION FOR THE NATIONAL GUN DOG CHAMPIONSHIP

All Vizslas running in the National Gun Dog Championship and Open Puppy Stake must be free of any disqualifying faults as stated in the Vizsla Standard recognized by the American Kennel Club.

To comply with this requirement, Linda Kelly will examine the dogs in this competition. All dogs (except for those dogs with a permanent qualification number) entered in this trial will be examined prior to the running in the stake in which they are entered. Examination will take place on the field trial grounds in a private location selected by the Field Trial Committee.

It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to present his/her dog for evaluation.

Linda Kelly will examine entrants for the QOL at the field trial grounds between 7:30 a.m. and noon on Monday, April 16, 2007 and at other scheduled times to be announced at the trial.

Procedure for Dogs with Permanent Qualification

The Permanent Qualification Number must be included on the entry form. Dogs with permanent qualification are qualified for all future VCA field events even if the breed-specific disqualifications in the standard for the Vizsla breed change. Dogs that qualify when less than 24 months of age do not have permanent qualification and are not qualified for future VCA field events.

The Vizsla Standard recognized by the American Kennel Club states the following disqualifications:

- Completely black nose.
- Solid white extending above the toes or white anywhere else on the dog except the fore chest.
- White extending on the shoulders or neck.
- A distinctly long coat.
- Males over 25-1/2 inches or under 20-1/2 inches in height. (Height measurements are taken at the highest point over the shoulder blades.)
- Females over 24-1/2 inches or under 19-1/2 inches in height. (Height measurements are taken at the highest point over the shoulder blades.)

These are the only breed-specific disqualifications and thus are the **ONLY STANDARDS THAT WILL BE EVALUATED.**
