PLEASE NOTE: The Alliant Energy Center charges \$8.00 per day for parking.

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is on site, located in the show buildings near lobby entrance.

NOTE: In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. Certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders, and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote, and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during, or after the event, shall belong solely to the American Kennel Club and their respective assigns including the names likeness, or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders, and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder, or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition. NOTE: Entering this show all owners, handlers, breeders, and kennels agree to make themselves available for interviews if requested.

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf Most important to note are the following:

- Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- 2. Dogs are éligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf

If you have questions or need assistance with registration or obtaining an extension, please contact the AKC Special Services Department at: awards@akc.org or (919) 233-9767 (followed by selecting option 4).

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors on Wednesday at 1:00 P.M., or at the discretion of the Show Committee. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately after Best in Show judging on Sunday. Dogs will be allowed overnight in grooming areas. Dogs and equipment will be the sole responsibility of owners and agents. The Alliant Energy Center and/or the Renaissance Cluster cannot be held responsible for dogs or equipment. Leave dogs at your own risk.
- All ex-pen debris must be cleaned up. There is a large outdoor area for ex-pens surrounding the building, which
 is covered to protect the dogs from the weather. No indoor ex-pens allowed.
- Dogs left overnight in the facility must have emergency contact number posted on crates.
- Please keep your indoor and outdoor areas clean.
- Show Chairman will not show dogs.
- Food Service will be available in the New Holland Pavilion near the Lobby.
- Shower facilities available.
- Crates will be allowed ringside 15 minutes prior to judging and must be removed immediately following the judging of that breed.
- Prizes will be awarded to the person showing the dog who will be considered as the owner or authorized agent.
 The Show Superintendent and the Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes. All trophies must be claimed at the show. They will not be sent to the winners.
- NO BABY STROLLERS allowed in buildings.

- Only AKC eligible dogs are allowed in the show Buildings.
- All exhibitors are responsible to clean up after their dogs.
- DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A SHORT LEASH. NO FLEXI-LEADS.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for all property damage caused by them at hotels or Show Grounds and will be charged accordingly.

- Mail All Entries With Fees to MB-F, Inc., Superintendent, P.O. Box 22107, Greensboro, NC 27420. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please verify your entry with the MB-F Office in North Carolina.

Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express number, expiration date and cardholder's name must appear on each entry. Fax entries must be received by the closing hour/date. - No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. - An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

- Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
- Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. 

Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or has stitches anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the event grounds.


